1. USE

The HDMI socket is an audio-video socket for connecting terminals such as plasma or LCD televisions, home-cinema systems, DVD recorders, satellite demodulators, etc. The connection is a high-fidelity digital format. To ensure quality output, the connection between the two devices should not exceed 10 m. For longer connections, it is necessary to provide an amplification system in the installation. The connectors are type A and conform to the HDMI 1.3 standard.
